## I appreciate Resonate's articulation of the spheres of God's mission.

Jesus' words about Judea and Samaria, and the ends of the earth don't simply mean "everywhere." His command paints a picture of what living out God's mission means.

### Jerusalem:: Your Home, Your Church

Jesus begins by reminding us that God's mission starts at home. Resonate helps equip each Christian to live out their faith right where they are.

### Judea: Culturally Similar, Geographically Near

Next, Jesus reminds his disciples to proclaim his gospel to the entire region, showing how important it is to join with what God is doing in the workplace, in the grocery store, around the neighborhood, and more.

### Samaria: Culturally Different, Geographically Near

Jesus' disciples would have taken note of being sent to Samaria, a place in their backyard populated by people different than them. Most people avoided Samaria for these cultural reasons. Jesus is reminding us that the redemption he brings isn't just for the people we are comfortable with! In today's world, people from around the world live right in our backyards and so Jesus' command to be witnesses "in Samaria" is especially important to remember!

### The ends of the earth: Culturally Different, Geographically Far

Our work on God's mission isn't done until people from every nation, tribe, and tongue worship Jesus! That's why Jesus includes the whole world in his final instructions on earth. The church is called to have a global perspective, investing in God's work everywhere.
