Good Friday, Brock Mission Cameron House.

Brock Mission in Peterborough endeavours to provide emergency crisis shelter, food, clothing and support to those in our community who find themselves in need, and to provide links with existing community services. Cameron House is a local emergency shelter for women over the age of 18 years. There are 10 shelter beds, and it provides 8 supported semi independent living suites to former homeless or at-risk people who are ready to transition to more independent living. Cameron house welcomes some special items that they are always in need of: coffee, sugar, milk, sliced bread, fresh produce, bath towels, shampoo, razors, feminine hygiene products and washable blankets.

Easter Sunday, Ministry Shares.

Today's offering is for Denominational Ministry Shares. You add; God multiplies! The money is divided among CRC agencies and institutions such as Back to God Ministries International, Calvin College, Christian Reformed Missions, according to a formula set by synod. Most of it — more than 85 cents of every dollar — goes directly into ministry programs: helping to send missionaries around the world, starting new churches, training pastors and leaders, and reaching out to our neighbors through the media and programs of evangelism. The rest helps to pay for denominational services and synodical and fundraising expense.
